Anglican Youth Gathering III of the Church in the Province of the West Indies

The Anglican Church will be hosting Provincial Youth Gathering III in Grenada from July 16-23, 2016. This youth gathering is the premier youth event of the Church in the Province of the West Indies which is the member-church of the Anglican Communion in the Caribbean.

Provincial Youth Gathering III is held under the theme: **“Anglican Youth – Co-workers with Christ: Living the Faith.”** It will bring together 160 young persons from Grenada and the rest of the CPWI-Caribbean for a week of prayer, study and reflection on the 5 Marks of Mission of the Anglican Communion.

These 5 marks of mission are:

- To proclaim the Good News of the Kingdom
- To teach, baptize and nurture new believers
- To respond to human need by loving service
- To transform unjust structures of society, to challenge violence of every kind and pursue peace and reconciliation
- To strive to safeguard the integrity of creation, and sustain and renew the life of the earth
